Some general information

Days 1 and 2

The conference will take in Lille, which is in the North of France. It is also an hour by train from Paris (through the Gare du Nord, one of the 5 train stations in Paris). Trains run almost between every two hours and thirty minutes depending on the time of day. There are two train stations in Lille (Gare Flandres and Gare Lille Europe) but they are both in the city center within walking distance of the conference venue.

As you may have noticed, we’ll end the second day of the conference earlier so we can all travel back to Paris.

Day 3

On Friday, January 10, the conference will take place at the University of Marne-la-Vallée, which is one of the Paris suburbs. The university is accessible by the A line of a train called RER. There are several stops in Paris (on the Champs-Élysées; near the Opera house; Châtelet; Gare de Lyon).

Train booking

Train reservations are open early October at the following website. We advise you to arrive at least the day before (Tuesday 7) but it’s also possible to catch the first train on January 8. It leaves Paris at 6:46 a.m. and arrives around 7:45, which will give you time to go to the conference venue.
